CHAT

- Is there something that you would look for if you lost it? When would you stop looking?
- What do the words lost and found mean in this part of the Bible?
- Who is lost in your school? City? World?
- When do you feel lost?
- What does it feel like to be found?
- When have you noticed God with you?
- When does God stop wanting you to be found?

COIN REMINDERS

- This activity could last for a few days or even weeks!
- In your Sunday School bag, you'll find a plastic coin.
- Show everyone in your family the coin and tell them the plan. The idea is that whenever you see the coin, you get a reminder that God treasures YOU!
- Each person in the family gets to put the coin in a place for another family member to discover it.
- You can leave just the coin or you can put a note with it too.
- Don't hide it too well. The point is for it to be found by the person so that they can enjoy the reminder and pass it on to another member of the family.
